

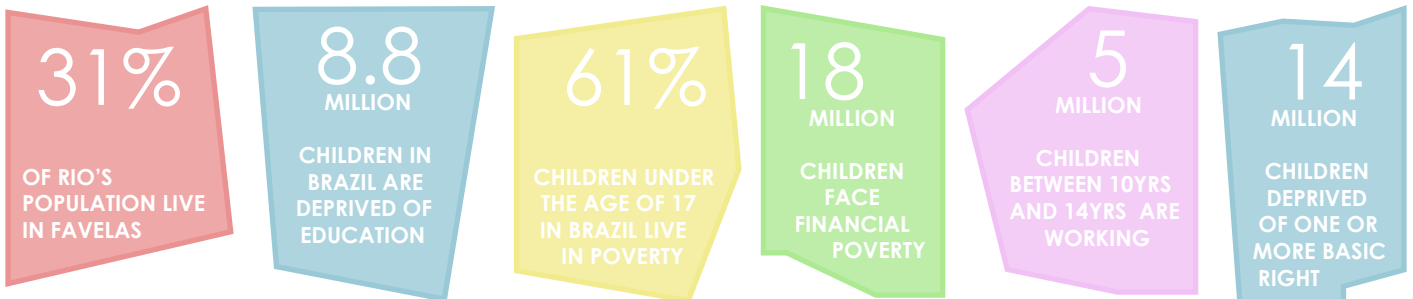
# THE FAVELA FOUNDATION

In the face of this adversity you will still find people defiantly achieving the kind of success that prior generations could have only dreamed; jobs in the city, professional footballing contracts and even Olympic gold medals. These are all made possible by the remarkable work of local NGOs and grassroots projects that provide educational support, training facilities, and most importantly a safe environment that offers the freedom to believe in a brighter future.



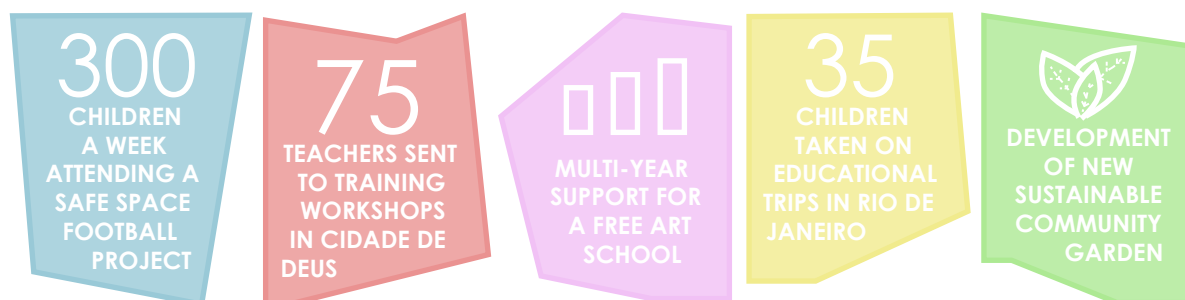
## ABOUT THE FAVELA FOUNDATION & OUR IMPACT

The Favela Foundation was set up in 2017 through four friends' shared experience of living and working in Rocinha, Brazil's largest favela. Our aim is to support educational and social welfare projects for the people living in some of Brazil's marginalised communities. By working alongside local, grassroots projects, we help them access financial support, and create meaningful opportunities for those most in need. We now work regularly with partners across multiple favelas in Rio de Janeiro, and are ever expanding our reach to help more people in need of support.

It is our firm belief that access to education and social welfare should not be restrictive and, together with our partners, we work towards a brighter future where there are no boundaries to these opportunities.

## NAME THE ...



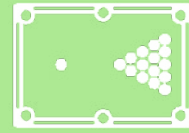
Teddy, bunny, whatever you choose. A guessing game with a fee to enter, and the chance to win a cuddly toy!

As a charity we know that together we are stronger, but will you be stronger than your friends?



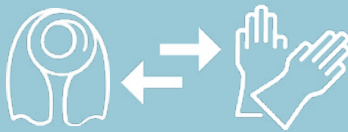

## FUNDRAISING TIPS

1. Tell Everyone – the first rule of fundraising is to make sure everyone knows what you're doing, and why! Share your journey, your milestones, and lots of photos of your training and planning! Make sure you tag The Favela Foundation too so we can share your story.
2. Set yourself a target! Make sure it's ambitious, but achievable. You can always increase it later.
3. Plan ahead – don't leave it to the last minute. We would recommend at least 4-6 weeks to tell people about your fundraising before the big day! The longer the run-up, the more chance you have of hitting your target. (Marathons, events etc give yourself 3-6months!)
4. Don't be afraid to ask! Ask people to donate, share the link to your fundraising page, see if a local business will donate a prize for your raffle. Because if you don't ask...
5. Say Thank You! Show your appreciation and tell people about the difference their donations have made.
6. And most importantly – have fun!



# SETTING UP YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

If you set up a fundraising page your money will be sent straight to The Favela Foundation, and it will also be easier for us to collect gift aid which could increase your donations by 25%!
